1. PhotoNack.com's Photo Tip of the Week (\$0)

2. Pictures of YOU! (\$1)

Family and friends love to get pictures of you that they can enjoy all year 'round.

3. Gift Certificates (\$1)

In a pinch? Gift certificates are always a good call. You can purchase a gift card in any denomination, so you can get them an accessory or a full blown rig. Gift cards can carry a balance, so they don't have to be used up all at one time.

4. Cap Keepers (\$3)

How many times have you misplaced your lens cover? A simple lanyard that ties your lens cover to the camera will keep the cap from getting lost.

5. Camera Film (\$4)

Still shooting on film? Put it in the stocking and have it available for opening gifts!

6. Lens Cloth (\$5)

Lens cloths are made with special micro fiber weaves and are designed to be lint free - Check out the Spudz for \$5, not available on precision-camera.com, sorry.

7. Lens Cleaning Solutions (\$5)

Don't just splash water on your lenses to clean them. Lens cleaning solutions are formulated to protect the special coatings on your lenses.

8. Lens & Body Caps (\$5)

Lens caps and body caps keep your lenses lint, smudge and scratch free when not in use. Keep a spare around in case you lose the first one. Dusty lenses can transfer dust to the sensor requiring an expensive cleaning. Know your manufacturer and lens diameter before placing your order.

9. Lens Brush (\$6)

This nifty little lipstick tube sized cylinder conceals a lens brush. Great for any photographer's gadget bag.

10. Rain Sleeves (\$7)

If you shoot outside, bad weather can sneak up on you. Don't let your camera get caught in a downpour without a raincoat.

11. Photo Calendars (\$8)

\$7.99 for a 1 year at a glance calendar from the Precision Camera Photolab.

12. One Time Use Cameras (\$8)

Great stocking stuffers. Handy to give kids to capture their unique points of view and it gives them experience working with cameras before handing over the expensive digital gear.

13. Battery Travel Chargers (\$8)

20. Blank CD's and DVD's (\$10)

Archiving images is an important part of photographer's work flow. Blank media always comes in handy.

21. Battery Car Chargers (\$10)

Does your photographer like to take pictures on hiking trips and outdoor activities? A car charger might come in really handy on those outings.

22. Photo Bags Small (\$12)

This effect is often used to increase the contrast and saturation in blue skies and white clouds.
